




#### How a STELLAR lesson looks like...



#### 1.Shared Reading Experiences


Children read a storybook with their teacher and engage in oral discussions with their teacher and peers.



#### 3. Language Use Activities in Learning Centres

The teacher prepares mini lessons based on specific needs of children to prepare them for reading & writing activities; e.g. grammar, vocabulary, word recognition, decoding skills, spelling etc.

#### 2. Shared Writing Experiences



The teacher models writing using children's language. Children engage in writing together and independently.






#### Speaking @ Yuhua

E.g. Turn taking, agreeing/disagreeina respectfully, etc.





### Strategies/Activities to build up speaking skills

Conversational "Catch" and Daily Conversations

**Role Play** 

**Show and Tell** 

[5W1H as prompts]







#### 1. Conversational "Catch"

**Player 1 (Parent):** Throws a ball while asking a question. "How's school?"

**Player 2 (Child):** Catches and answers the question. But before throwing the ball back, he/she must ask another related question. ("Good! Guess what I did for Art class?")

Your child understands the back-and-forth nature of conversations and feels comfortable starting and continuing conversations.



#### 2. Role Play

You and your child can act out an interesting segment of a book/cartoon/movie.


It is a powerful way for children to learn the ways of effective communication as they develop self-confidence, creative imagination and expression.





#### 3. Show and Tell

Select an item (e.g. your child's favourite new toy) and prompt the chi to talk about the item using the **5W1H** questions.
