Full Home-Based Learning (HBL) from 8 April to 4 May

In line with the Multi-Ministry Taskforce's latest efforts to further enhance safe distancing measures, schools will step up their safe distancing measures. **From 8 April 2020, all MOE schools will shift to full Home-Based Learning (HBL) till 4 May 2020.**

During the period of full HBL, schools will provide instructions and support for your child to access a range of both online and hardcopy HBL resources so that learning can continue. The HBL Timetable and HBL weekly plan will be published on school website. Form teachers will also send to you the daily plans for HBL via Parents Gateway.

Parents and students can call **6425 5659** between 8.00am and 4.00pm (Monday to Friday) to seek clarifications on matters pertaining to the HBL lessons from the teachers on duty. Parents can also send an email to your child's/ward's respective Form Teachers and subject teachers.

If your child needs learning or emotional support, he/she can approach our teachers and other school personnel such as our allied educators and school counsellors, who will continue to work from home or from school. Our teachers will also be in regular contact with you and your child.

All school-based Mid-Year Examinations will be cancelled. However, national examinations, including Primary School Leaving Examinations will proceed as planned and with the necessary precautionary measures in place. Our teachers will continue to monitor the progress of your child/ward through HBL assignments.

Student care centres will suspend their general services during this period but will provide limited services to a selected group of students with parents who are unable to make alternative childcare arrangements as they are both working in essential services. If you are working in essential services, and are unable to secure alternative care arrangements, you may approach the school for assistance.


Growing Our Hearts and Minds
